Identifying delays early on allows experts to create individualized plans and perform the appropriate interventions that will improve a child's ability to thrive.



Screenings address both specific and general developmental areas, such as specific disorders like Autism, specific areas like cognitive development, language, socialemotional development, and gross and fine motor skills, as well as more general, overall health and development.

Identifying a family's needs through the screening process creates the opportunity to provide Wyoming families with resources, services, and support.
