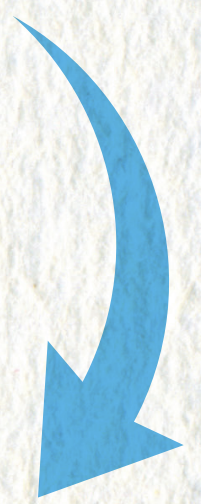

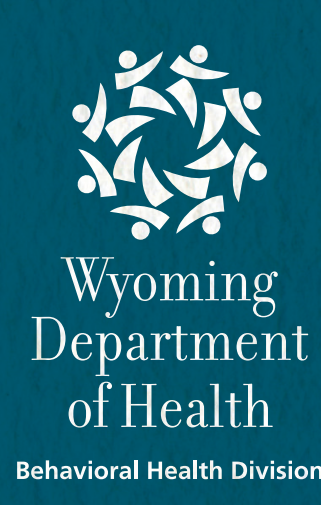
Using all their senses to explore anything unfamiliar until it becomes familiar
