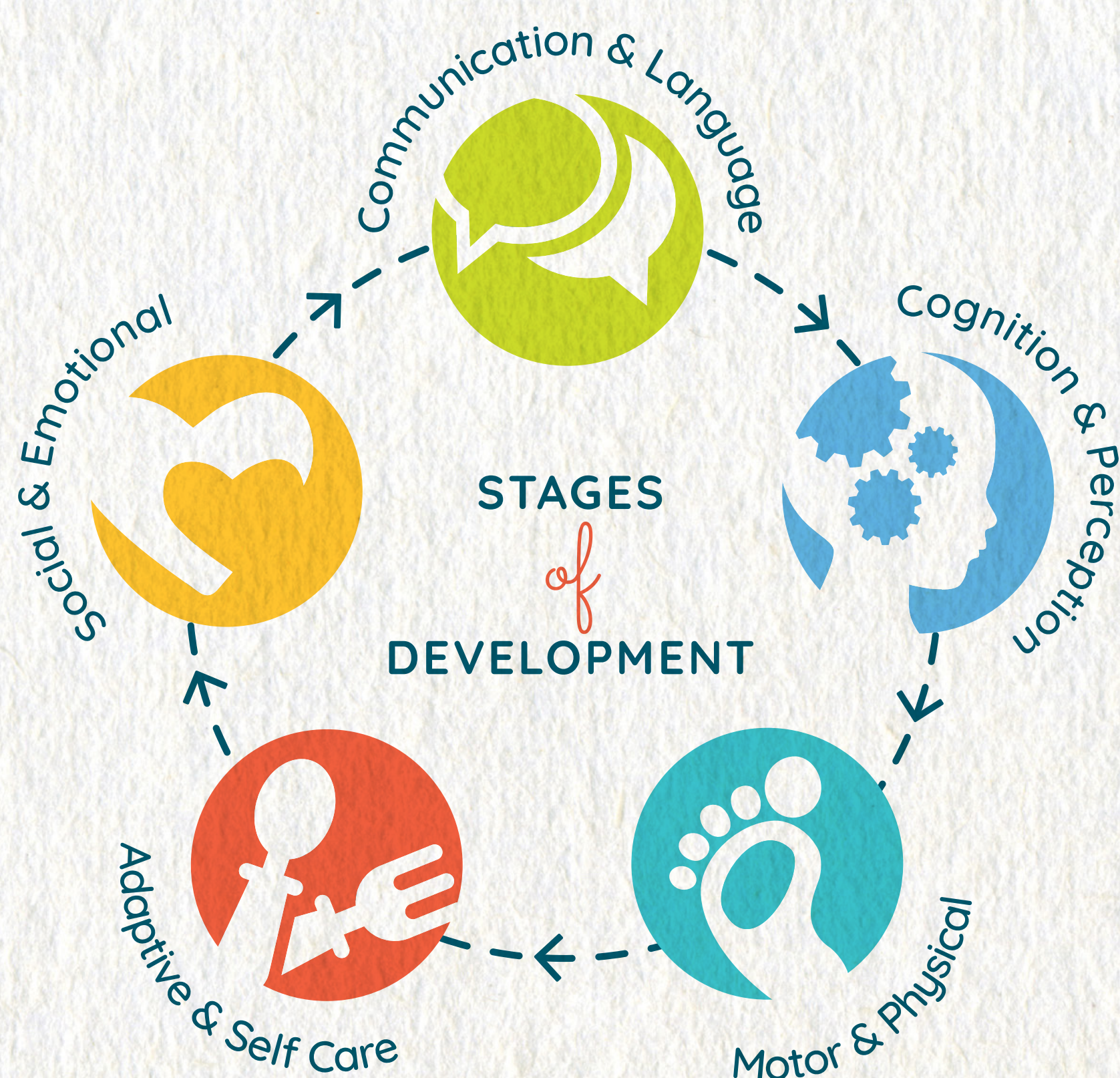


The name **“Screen for Success”** refers to: Early childhood developmental **screenings** for **successful** (healthy) growth and development

Our motto is, **“The more you know, the better they grow.”** We believe the more you understand what’s going on with your child’s development, the better equipped you will be – with knowledge, resources, and support – to care for and guide them through healthful growth.

**Child Development Centers** across Wyoming provide **free screenings and developmental services**, including **Early Intervention and Education Programs** for children aged birth - 5, as well as family support for children with delays or disabilities.

At CDCs and in other early childhood settings, a child’s **development is categorized in different stages**. By looking at milestones that children meet within these different stages, we can keep track of the many ways children develop.



Screen for Success is here to show families, child care providers, and early childhood educators what screenings look like, why they are so great for healthy development, and how to access screenings in Wyoming.
